U.S.-China Arts Exchange Endowed

Han Xu, Chinese ambassador to the United States, addressed guests at a reception for the Center for U.S.-China Arts Exchange at the Chinese Mission to the United Nations May 12. At the reception professor Chou Wen-chung, founder and director of the Columbia-based Center, announced the establishment of an endowment for the Center and the receipt of \$1.12 million in contributions. It is the first time a U.S. organization devoted exclusively to cultural exchange with China has been endowed.
